



Irrigation Audit Registration Application

A new irrigation audit component has been added to the previous certification program requirements and to all future water management trainings. Completion of the irrigation audit component is a requirement for anyone who has passed the written test prior to March 2010 to comply with the new certification requirements. It also enables certified water managers to become an EPA WaterSense Partner through CLCA.

The new irrigation audit component is important brings additional credibility to the program certification with the addition of the EPA WaterSense label, gives water managers some additional tools to use in the field and ensures all certified water managers have completed the same program curriculum.

You must complete the irrigation audit component to renew your water manager certification in 2011.

If you are already an EPA WaterSense Partner through another organization, you are still required to complete the irrigation audit component to fulfill the new water manager certification program requirements. Other organization's training or certifications do not fulfill the irrigation audit component requirement.
